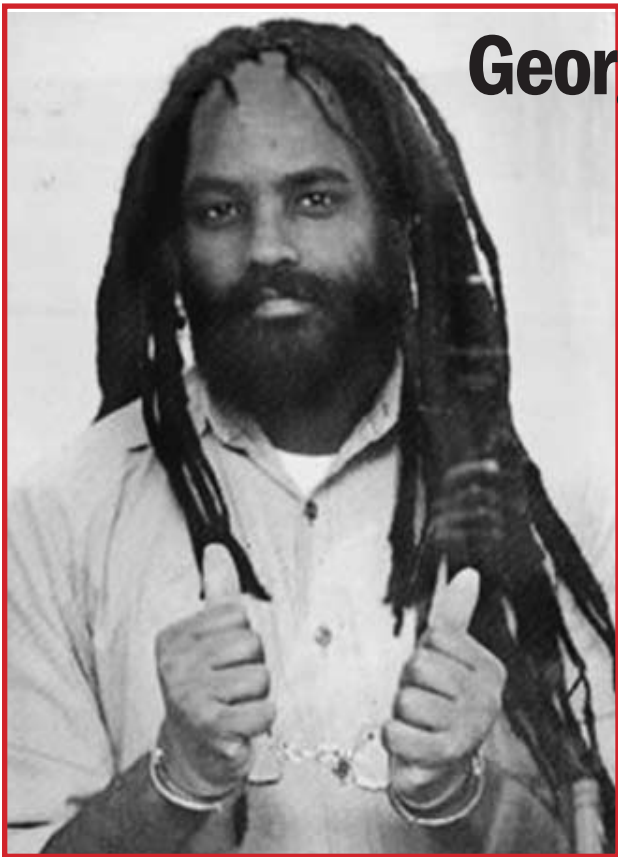


Don't let them kill an innocent man



George Bush wants Mumia Abu-Jamal executed

FREE Mumia Abu-Jamal

For 25 years Mumia Abu-Jamal has been on Pennsylvania's death row. A federal appeals court will be hearing his case in Philadelphia on May 17.

As governor of Texas, George Bush executed 152 people, including the innocent Shaka Sankofa. Bush appointed Pennsylvania Gov. Tom Ridge—who signed two death warrants for Mumia Abu-Jamal—as Secretary of Homeland Security.

Mumia's trial was a frame-up. The prosecution deliberately excluded Black jurors to create an overwhelmingly white jury. Check out the facts:

- ✓ As a radio journalist, Mumia earned the hatred of Philadelphia's cops for exposing their brutality. Racist Philadelphia Mayor Frank Rizzo publicly threatened to "get" Mumia at a news conference.
- ✓ Mumia Abu-Jamal was driving a cab in Philadelphia on Dec. 9, 1981 when he saw a policeman beating his brother. Mumia was shot by this cop, Daniel Faulkner, as he ran to stop the beating. Arnold Beverly confessed in 2001 to killing Faulkner.
- ✓ Over 120 witnesses were present. The prosecution called only six. Two of these witnesses—Cynthia White and Veronica Jones—later said they were forced to lie because cops threatened to jail them. Three key witnesses either died or disappeared within days of the shootings.
- ✓ Mumia's gun, carried for self-defense, wasn't even

tested for the smell of gunpowder. A medical examiner said that Faulkner was killed by a .44 caliber bullet. Yet Mumia's gun was a .38 caliber.

- ✓ Photos taken at the scene shortly after these shootings prove that police moved evidence in order to help frame Mumia Abu-Jamal. Policeman James Forbes can be seen smudging both Jamal's and Faulkner's weapons, destroying any potential fingerprint evidence.
- ✓ Some witnesses saw the shooter run away. But Mumia was found lying at the scene.
- ✓ Mumia Abu-Jamal is facing execution because of his history as a defender of the people. When he was 15 years old, Mumia was one of the founders of the Philadelphia chapter of the Black Panther Party. The prosecution told the jury at his trial that Mumia's membership in the Panthers was evidence of his intent to kill!
- ✓ In 2007 Don Imus slandered the Rutgers Women's basketball team. In 1995 the judge who sentenced Mumia to death—Albert Sabo—said "I'm going to help 'em fry that n----r" in the presence of court stenographer Terri Maurer-Carter.

George Bush let Black people drown in New Orleans. Bush and all the bigots want to silence Mumia forever. Will we let them execute an innocent man? Come to Philadelphia's Federal Courthouse, at 6th and Market, on Thursday, May 17 at 9 am to make your voice heard.

Bring the troops home now!

How many more people have to die for Bush and the billionaires? Researchers at the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health have estimated that 600,000 Iraqi people have died during the U.S. occupation. So have over 3,300 GIs.

But war has been swell for ExxonMobil and the rest of Big Oil. Exxon made \$35 billion in profit last year. Before the U.S. invaded Iraq, the government there used oil money to fund free health care and public education. Wouldn't it be great if ExxonMobil paid your doctor bills?

The Pentagon admitted that it flew 363 tons of cash worth \$12 billion into Iraq. How much of this money went right into the pockets of Bush's supporters?

Mumia Abu-Jamal pointed out that Haliburton charged GIs \$99 to wash their clothes—and didn't even do a good job! Cheney continues to draw "deferred compensation" from Haliburton.

Everybody knows that Bush lied about "weapons of mass destruction" in Iraq. There weren't any.

They framed up Iraq just like they framed up Mumia Abu-Jamal.

That didn't prevent the White House from scaring people with images of mushroom clouds. GIs coming home poisoned by depleted uranium (DU) are ignored.

Now the same lies are being used to threaten Iran. Two aircraft carriers have been sent to the Arab/Persian Gulf.

The U.S. continues to occupy Afghanistan and bomb families there. Haiti is occupied under cover of the United Nations after the CIA overthrew President Aristide in 2004.

The \$500 billion Pentagon budget represents \$1,666 stolen from every woman, man and child in the country. Think about that when you ride in crowded buses, hear about hospitals closing, find out that college tuition has increased again and wonder why young people can't get jobs.

Justice for Sean Bell

New York City police fired 50 shots at Sean Bell on Nov. 25, 2006, killing the unarmed man on his wedding day. Their 41 shots killed the unarmed African immigrant Amadou Diallo in 1999.

Philadelphia cops are just as vicious. They killed 20 people within the city limits last year and another two victims outside the city.

Police in Philadelphia greeted 2007 by killing unarmed Bryan Jones on Jan 1. By Feb. 11 they killed another three people.

In 1979 the United States Justice Department charged Mayor Rizzo and the Philadelphia Police Department with beating confessions out of prisoners, shooting unarmed suspects and abusing African-American and Latin@ people.

Twenty-eight years later on April 3, 2007, 19-year old Army reservist Angel Rodriguez was beaten by Philadelphia cops for videotaping their brutality. "The one cop came and punched me in my mouth, then they threw me on the floor," Rodriguez told Channel 10. "After they were done smashing the camera, then they hit me with the nightstick."

These members of the Fraternal Order of Police are demanding Mumia Abu-Jamal be executed. They're mad

that the city of St. Denis in France named a street after this freedom fighter who exposed their brutality.

Don't let them kill Mumia Abu-Jamal!

What are they afraid of?

The Federation of Police (FOP) and their political allies have gone berserk over a suburb of Paris, St. Denis, naming a street after Mumia Abu-Jamal. A resolution condemning this act of solidarity was rammed through the U.S. House of Representatives by a vote of 368-31.

This is the same Congress that continues to fund the Iraq war. Instead of helping to lynch a Black political prisoner on death row, why can't they raise the minimum wage to \$10 or \$12 per hour? Just to equal the purchasing power of the minimum wage in 1968 you'll need \$9.44 per hour.

It isn't just the French who recognize that Mumia was framed. So have people around the world, including Nelson Mandela and the African National Congress.

When the Philadelphia Police Department's "Emerald Society" visited Derry, in British occupied Northern Ireland, they spotted Mumia's portrait on a wall. These hooligans vandalized it in the middle of the night. But the local Irish residents repainted it.

The cops are trying to crush the free speech rights of anyone who stands up for Mumia Abu-Jamal. The FOP forced Philadelphia's Clef Club—"the house that jazz built"—to cancel a celebration on April 24, Mumia's 53rd birthday. So Mumia supporter Danny Glover appeared in person instead at the

American Friends Service Committee (the Quakers).

The FOP's fellow thugs in New York compelled the Remote Lounge to cancel an April 15th hip hop concert, which was held elsewhere. Two days earlier the lounge was issued 16 spurious citations.

It was revealed at an April 23rd news conference that cops discussed having the Hells Angels attack the concert. That's more than intimidation—that's terrorism.

These police state tactics were denounced in front of New York's City Hall by Attorney Michael Tarif Warren, City Councilperson Charles Barron and Monica Moorehead, of Millions for Mumia and the International Action Center.

Orie Lumumba, of the NYC Coalition to Free Mumia Abu-Jamal, chaired the conference. The coalition's co-chair, Dr. Suzanne Ross, said that it was continuing its campaign to name a street in Harlem after Mumia Abu-Jamal. (If you would like to help, contact them at 212-330-8029.)

Working in tandem with the cops is Philadelphia's District Attorney's office, which tried to have the Third Circuit Federal Appeals Court kick itself off Mumia's case. No way, said the court. As Monica Moorehead said at the New York news conference: "All out for May 17th!" at Philadelphia's federal courthouse!

Why they hate Mumia

For nearly 40 years Mumia Abu-Jamal has been fighting for the people. Mumia was 14 in 1968 and attending Philadelphia's Benjamin Franklin High School when he booed George Wallace. The Alabama Governor was running for president with the Ku Klux Klan's endorsement.

A policeman stood by while a gang of bigots attacked Mumia at the Wallace rally. "The cop saw me on the ground being beaten to a pulp, marched over briskly—and kicked me in the face," Mumia later wrote.

The FBI noted the young activist and started a file that ran to 600 pages. In 1969 Mumia helped found the Philadelphia chapter of the Black Panther Party.

After a mentally challenged Black youth was killed by the police, Mumia—the chapter's Lieutenant of Information—sprung into action. Fellow Panther Rosemari Mealy recalled that "flyers and posters appeared overnight in every Black neighborhood all over the city" to denounce this atrocity.

Frank Rizzo was Philadelphia's police commissioner. When 3,500 African-American high school students marched for Black studies in 1967, Rizzo ordered his cops to "get their black asses." Police obeyed their boss by clubbing anyone in sight.

This is the same police department that has been trying to kill Mumia Abu-Jamal for 25 years. A bullet fragment that could prove Mumia's innocence "disappeared" from police files.

Rizzo hated the Panthers and the Free Breakfast for Children program they started in South Philadelphia. Cops with automatic weapons raided three Panther offices on August 31, 1970. Black men were forced to strip naked like they were slaves.

This didn't stop over 10,000 people from coming the following week to the Revolutionary Peoples' Constitutional Convention that the Panthers convened at Temple University.

Rizzo was rewarded for his brutality by being elected Philadelphia's mayor in 1971. The pig urged his followers to "vote white."

The FBI and local police departments tried to exterminate the Black Panther Party. At least 28 Panthers were killed. Some are still in prison today, like Marshall "Eddie" Conway in Maryland or Herman Wallace and Albert Woodfox, locked-up in Louisiana's Angola Prison.

Getting rid of Mumia Abu-Jamal is part of this unfinished business. Mumia was tortured by cops on Dec. 9, 1981. His head was rammed into a light pole. Mumia was then driven around for nearly an hour, in hopes he would bleed to death, before being dumped on the floor of an emergency room.

The Federation of Police and Philadelphia's Don Imus—Michael Smerconish—want Mumia Abu-Jamal executed. Don't let them conduct another lynching.

Never forget May 13, 1985

Five children and six adults burned to death when the MOVE Organization's headquarters were bombed in Philadelphia on May 13, 1985. Terrorists from the Philadelphia Police Department, aided by the Pentagon and FBI, dropped a satchel bomb from a helicopter.

Cops let the fire burn for over 10 hours. They kept shooting at the house to prevent anyone escaping. So much ammunition was used that police had to get more bullets from their armory.

Ramona Africa and nine-year old Birdie Africa were the only ones to survive. Both suffered third-degree burns.

After this holocaust Ramona Africa was charged with arson. She spent seven years in jail.

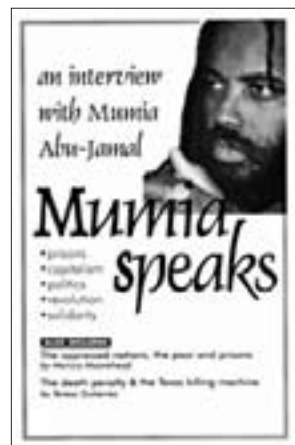
The cops and FBI didn't care about children being burned alive. Nor were

they concerned about the neighborhood. Sixty-one homes were burned down on Osage Avenue in West Philadelphia.

Lynne Abraham, then a judge, issued the warrants that served as an excuse for this massacre. Today Abraham is Philadelphia's District Attorney and wants Mumia Abu-Jamal executed.

Racist Mayor Rizzo hated MOVE and its founder, John Africa. Rizzo staged a police raid upon the MOVE house in Powelton Village in 1978. The cops were so reckless that they killed James Ramp, a fellow police officer, with a bullet in the neck.

Nine MOVE members were framed and imprisoned for this killing. Merle Africa died suspiciously in jail on March 13, 1998. Justice demands the MOVE 9 be freed.

Philadelphia style jury fixing

People were outraged when they saw the videotape of Rodney King being clubbed 56 times by Los Angeles cops. The racism of the Philadelphia District Attorney's office was also recorded.

Assistant D.A. Jack McMahon made a training film in the late 1980s on how to exclude African Americans from juries. Here are some excerpts:

"The case law says the object of getting a jury... is to get a competent, fair and impartial jury. Well that's ridiculous..."

"Let's face it... the Blacks from the low-income areas are less likely to convict... you don't want those people on your jury..."

"Another factor, in selecting Blacks, you don't want the real educated ones. This goes across the board. All races..."

No wonder Mumia Abu-Jamal's jury had only two African-American members! Prosecutor Joseph McGill excluded at least 10 Black jurors. Mumia should get a new trial just because of this videotaped tampering.

The 25-year-long lie

The biggest lie being used to try to kill Mumia Abu-Jamal is that he confessed. It was claimed at Mumia's 1982 trial that he shouted in the hospital, "I shot the m----f---r and I hope he dies."

This is the sort of manufactured testimony that a dirty prosecutor uses to inflame a jury. It was a deliberate effort to appeal to the racism of the ten white jurors.

Police officer Gary Bell and hospital security guard Priscilla Durham testified about this alleged outburst. Yet Bell didn't mention any "confession" when he was interviewed by detectives on Dec. 16, 1981—a week after Daniel Faulkner was killed.

Only 71 days later on Feb. 25, 1982 did Bell suddenly recall this incident while being questioned by investigators from the police department's Internal Affairs division. He claims that until then his memory had been "repressed."

Bell was Faulkner's partner. Is it believable that a cop could "forget" such a confession for over two months?

Priscilla Durham knew Daniel Faulkner personally. She waited until Feb. 2, 1982—55 days after the shooting—to claim that Mumia "confessed."

At his trial Mumia Abu-Jamal asked Ms. Durham why it took her so long to make a statement. Judge Albert Sabo prevented the witness from answering and threw Mumia out of the courtroom.

Policeman Gary Wakshul was continuously with the wounded Mumia Abu-Jamal at the hospital. This cop wrote in his report that "the Negro male made no statement." Yet two months later Wakshul also told Internal Affairs investigators that Abu-Jamal "confessed."

While Bell and Durham were called to testify in Mumia Abu-Jamal's trial, Wakshul was not. On the last day of testimony Mumia's defense attorney discovered Wakshul's statement and sought to have him testify.

The prosecution said that the policeman was on vacation. Judge Sabo said it was too late in the trial to call Wakshul. Sabo told Abu-Jamal, on trial for his life, "You and your attorney goofed."

Only at a 1995 appeals hearing was it revealed that Gary Wakshul was at home waiting to be summoned. Mumia's attor-

neys didn't know that a few days before this hearing—on July 13, 1995—Wakshul was beaten-up by undercover cops from Philadelphia's vice squad.

A judge observed this attack which occurred in the courtroom where Wakshul was employed. Yet no criminal charges were brought against the thugs who assaulted Wakshul. Nearly two years later they were merely suspended without pay.

Gary Wakshul got the point. Despite his written report, he maintained at the 1995 hearing that Mumia "confessed."

Even more incredibly, Police inspector William Colarulo and Kathleen Gerrow, a producer at Philadelphia's Channel 10, have now claimed that Mumia Abu-Jamal "confessed."

"In 1982 it was unbelievable that police forgot about the confession for two months," said Pam Africa, chair of International Concerned Family and Friends of Mumia Abu-Jamal. "Now we're supposed to believe that it took 25 years for these new people to remember it?"

JOBS NOT JAILS

Over 2.2 million people are in prisons across the country. So why isn't George Bush locked-up? This serial killer has got blood on his hands from Iraq to New Orleans.

The United States is the greatest jailer on earth. With less than 5% of the world's

population it has 25% of the prison inmates. There are more Black men in prison than in college.

Over seven million people are in prison or on probation. The "criminal justice system" swallowed \$193 billion in 2004 that could have been spent on jobs, schools and health care.

The prison budget alone was \$62 billion. That's \$206 stolen from every person in the United States. Mumia Abu-Jamal attacks this "prison-industrial complex" while on Pennsylvania's death row.

From 1973 to 2003, 123 people on death row were found to be innocent, according to the Death Penalty Information Center. Some came within hours of being executed.

Because of the Cardozo Law School's "Innocence Project," Jerry Miller became the 200th person cleared by DNA evidence. Chicago prosecutors agreed on April 23rd that the African American could not have committed the rape he spent 25 years in jail for. When will the Philadelphia District Attorney's office admit that Mumia Abu-Jamal was framed?

Well over 100 murders have been committed in Philadelphia since New Year's Day. But it isn't poor people who pour drugs into the community. Thanks to George Bush over 80% of the heroin on the streets comes from U.S.-occupied Afghanistan. Big banks launder \$100 billion in drug profits annually.

Millionaire mayoral candidate Tom Knox wants to steal from the school budget to hire another thousand cops. More police brutality won't stop the murders. Young people need jobs not jail.

Mumia Abu-Jamal provides the world with an important history of the founding of the Philadelphia Black Panther Party in his book **We Want Freedom: A Life in the Black Panther Party**.

Mumia, known to the world as a wrongly convicted political prisoner held for 25 years in Pennsylvania's death row, is exacting and luminous in his history and his analysis of the Black liberation struggle.

George Bush quiere ejecutar a Mumia Abu-Jamal

Por más de 25 años Mumia Abu-Jamal ha permanecido en prisión condenado a muerte en Pensilvania. Una corte federal de apelaciones en Filadelfia oír su caso el 17 de mayo.

Mientras fue gobernador de Texas, George Bush ejecutó a 152 personas, incluyendo al inocente Shaka Sankofa. Bush postuló al gobernador de Pensilvania Tom Ridge, -- el cual ha firmado dos ordenes de muerte para Mumia Abu-Jamal— como Secretario de la Seguridad para la Patria.

El juicio de Mumia fue una farsa. La fiscalía deliberadamente excluyó a personas de raza negra como jurado para crear un jurado mayoritariamente compuesto de personas blancas. Revisemos los hechos:

- ✓ Como reportero radial, Mumia se ganó el odio de la policía de Filadelfia por exponer su brutalidad. El alcalde racista Frank Rizzo públicamente amenazó con "vengarse" de Mumia durante una conferencia de prensa.
- ✓ Mumia Abu-Jamal conducía un taxi en Filadelfia el 9 de Diciembre de 1981 cuando vio a un oficial de la policía golpeando a su hermano. Mumia recibió un disparo de este policía, Daniel Faulkner, cuando corría a detener la golpiza. Arnold Beverly confesó en el 2001 haber matado a Faulkner.
- ✓ Más de 120 testigos estaban presente. La fiscalía solo llamó a seis. Dos de estos testigos—Cynthia White y Verónica Jones—luego dijeron que fueron obligadas a mentir amenazadas por la policía de encarcelarles. Tres testigos importantes murieron o desaparecieron a los pocos días de la balacera.

- ✓ La pistola de Mumia, la cual llevaba para su defensa, ni siquiera fue examinada para ver si fue disparada. Un médico forense dijo que Faulkner murió por una bala de calibre .44, pero la pistola de Mumia era de calibre .38.
- ✓ Las fotografías tomadas en la escena del crimen poco después del suceso comprueban que la policía manejó la evidencia para ayudar a montar un caso contra Mumia Abu-Jamal. El oficial de la policía James Forbes se puede ver limpiando las armas de Jamal y Faulkner, destruyendo así cualquier evidencia de huellas digitales.

Justicia para Sean Bell

La policía de Nueva York disparó 50 balas a Sean Bell el 25 de noviembre de 2006, matando a este hombre desarmado en el día de su boda. Cuarenta y un tiros de la misma policía mató a un desarmado Amadou Diallo, inmigrante africano en 1999.

La Policía de Filadelfia es igualmente despiadada. El año pasado mató a 20 personas en la ciudad y a otras dos víctimas fuera de la línea limítrofe de la ciudad.

La policía en Filadelfia comenzó el año nuevo de 2007 matando a Bryan Jones, quien también estaba desarmado. Para el 11 de febrero ya habían matado otras tres personas.

En el 1979 el Departamento de Justicia de los EEUU acusó al entonces alcalde Rizzo y al Departamento de Policía con pegarle a prisioneros para obtener confesiones, disparar contra sospechosos desarmados y abusar a la gente africana-americana y latina.

Veintiocho años después, en el 3 de abril de 2007, el reservista del Ejército de los EEUU Ángel Rodríguez, fue golpeado por policías de Filadelfia por haber grabado un video de su brutalidad. "Un policía me dio un puñetazo en la boca, entonces ellos me tiraron al suelo", Rodríguez dijo al Canal 10. "Después de destrozar la cámara, me dieron un macanazo".

Estos miembros de la Orden Fraternal de Policía están demandando que Mumia Abu-Jamal sea ejecutado. Están furiosos porque la ciudad de St. Denis en Francia nombró una calle en honor de este luchador para la liberación que expuso la brutalidad de ellos.

Los mismos policías quieren que ustedes boicoteen a Paul Newman, Naomi Campbell, Spike Lee, los Backstreet Boys, y la marca popular de helado Ben and Jerry's por haber prestado su apoyo a Mumia Abu-Jamal. ¿Obedecerían ustedes?
